Media & Size Limitations

—two dimensional work only including photography and three dimensional-wall art/mixed media, no larger than 30"x50" or 1500 square inches nor heavier than

35 lbs. We cannot accommodate free standing sculptures. Original work only; no giclées or other reproductions.

—ASK's subject standard is, "if it cannot be hung in a library or public school, then ASK cannot accept it either. We are public/family oriented, members based organization."

—All work must be in good condition and ready to hang on the wall **with a wire**.

To Enter

—Drop off entries Tuesday February 28 between 1 and 5:30 pm.

—All images must have a completed ID label (supplied below) made out and attached to the front upon delivery.

—A gallery contract will be signed when work is delivered.

—A list of artist names and titles of accepted work will be posted at

www.askforarts.org after jurying -March 1.

—***Declined work **must be picked up**

Thursday or Friday March 1 or 2

between 1 and 5:30 pm.

—Accepted work will be displayed through March 31. Pickup is Tuesday April 3, 1-5:30 pm.

Sales and Insurance

—ASK will encourage sales and takes a 35% commission.

—All work submitted must be for sale.

—ASK will not be responsible for any damage to or theft of artwork before, during or after the show. Artists may arrange for their own insurance.

Submission Fees

First 2 images:

\$20 for ASK members/\$30 for non-members, \$5 for each additional entry.

Fees may be paid by check or cash only (*sorry no credit cards*) and are non-refundable..
